Built in 1873, the home has a rich history as part of Glenelg's community; originally as a homestead surrounded by farmland, then as the ANZAC Hostel during World War I and as a Red Cross convalescent hospital in World War II before its current use as a residential care home.

The history of the site will be on show, together with helpful advice and information about aged care. "We recognise that navigating aged care can be a daunting and complex task," says Kapara's manager Lyn Bertram. "We want to bring people together people in a relaxed setting so that they can ask questions and seek advice from people who understand the complexities."
