2.	Promoter	Aged Care and Housing Group Inc ABN 99 437 071 895 (ACH Group)
3.	Competition Period	Entry into the Competition commences at 12.00am 1 August 2026. Entry into the Competition closes at 11:50pm 31 August 2026.
4.	Venue Details	South Australian Living Artists Exhibition at: • Campbelltown Library; and • Woodcroft Neighbourhood Centre and Library (Exhibition).
5.	Eligible Persons	Artist Any person resident in South Australia above 18 years old who has their artwork displayed at the Exhibition is an entrant as an artist. Voter Any person resident in South Australia above 18 years old who submits a completed voting card at the Exhibition is an entrant as a voter. The Promoter's employees and executive leadership team are not eligible to enter.
6.	Maximum Number of Entries	One (1) entry per Eligible Person at each Exhibition during the Competition Period.
7.	Entry Method	Artist Any person who has their artwork displayed at the Exhibition is automatically entered into the Competition. Voter Entry into the Competition is by completing a voting card and placing it in the voting box at each Exhibition.
8.	Drawing the winners and further draws	Artist The artist who has the most votes at each Exhibition wins. There will be two winning artists, one from the Campbelltown Exhibition and one from the Woodcroft Exhibition. If a selected winner cannot be contacted, or is otherwise ineligible, the Promoter reserves the right to award the prize to the artist with the next most votes at the relevant Exhibition. Voter The winners will be determined by a random draw at ACH Group, 22 Henley Beach Rd, Mile End at 11.00am on Monday 7 September 2026. All valid voting cards from each Exhibition will be placed into separate containers and one card will be drawn at random to determine the winning voter for that Exhibition.

		There will be two winning voters, one from the Campbellton Exhibition and one from the Woodcroft Exhibition. The person whose name appears on the drawn voting card will be the winner. If the selected winner cannot be contacted, or is otherwise ineligible, the Promoter reserves the right to conduct a further random draw to determine an alternative winner.
